Small Group Study Guide- Ephesians 1:11-14

In the first 3 weeks we have discussed election from the Father, redemption through the Son and *inheritance* by the Holy Spirit.

1) Spiritual Inheritance: The eternal promise to those who are in Christ. (Eph. 1:11)

- How would you define inheritance? How does your personal definition match up with Eph. 1:11-14 and 1 Pet. 1:3-4?
- Paul says, "in" Him. Different than "from" Him. What do you think it means that our spiritual inheritance is in Christ opposed to something left behind from Him?

2) Spiritual Inheritance: The culmination of God's salvation plan. (Eph. 1:11)

- Predestination upholds God's sovereignty. What does it means when we say, "God is sovereign" and how does our understanding guide our lives? (See 1Tim. 6:12-16)
- How does understanding God's sovereign plan produce confidence in our lives? (See Col. 4:5-6)
- How is our spiritual inheritance the culmination of God's plan? What might that look like? (See 1 Cor. 13:9-10)

3) Spiritual Inheritance: The Holy Spirit is the proof of God's promise. (Eph. 1:12-14)

- The proof of earthly inheritance is tangible: a will. In Christ one receives the proof of inheritance: How does the Holy Spirit assure our inheritance? (See John 14:26)
- Look at Eph. 1:12-14. Identify and discuss the 4-steps of salvation.
