Thankful In All Situations: I Thessalonians 5:16-18

- Read I Corinthians 13:1-3. Do you struggle with the "punching the time clock" mentality of your walk with Christ?
- Love God, Love People is a vital part of our Church's mission. They are before the other two, Make Disciples and Reach the Lost. Why is that a good order?
- Of all the things you have is your salvation what you are most thankful for?
- When you slow down to consider your gratitude for God's gift of grace, how do you want to change your actions?
- Read 2 Timothy 4:6. Share how your life is being poured out, where you would like to pour out more.
- Pray that your group would commit to prayers of praise and thankfulness as much as petitioning.
