What God says should be heard.

Talk with the group about a time God called you to perform a certain act.

Talk about your experience from that moment.

What has been the hardest thing you believe God has asked you to do?

Cornelius seems to struggle for just a bit by worshipping the messenger instead of the One who sent him. Discuss with your group the problems that this can cause.

Peter had been struggling with partiality, do you still see this in society, whether in race, class, etc.. (James 2:1, 9)

What God sends should be received.

God has been adding to our numbers here at Grace, talk about some of the reasons you may think this is happening.

How well are we doing at receiving these new people, if you are new please chime in on this?

Hospitality towards people is one thing, how hospitable are we toward the Holy Spirit?

Ephesians 5:18 reminds us to be filled with the Spirit, what is a good litmus for knowing you are allowing that to happen?

Discuss the importance of giving God the credit for the great things going on at Grace.

Pray that Grace Church continues to operate under the Spirit's leading and that many more can be reached through her people and ministry.
