Second Impressions (Acts 28:5-6)

- Share a time your mind has changed instantly about someone. What happened to change your mind?

- Have you ever been double-minded about God? How does that affect your relationships?

Lasting Impression (Acts 28:7-10)

- Talk about an event or person that has left a lasting impression.
- What would you like said about your life 100 years from now? Are you striving to make that happen?
- Read Act 20:35. In what ways can you be generous as a small group with your time, talents and treasures? Think of ways that will leave a lasting impression.
